## PART III: PERSEVERE TO THE END

☐ SCRIPTURE: JAMES 1:9-12

**key theme:** Blessed is the one who does not give over or abandon what is undertaken, during suffering that puts strength, patience or faith to the test.

- Be Humble: Psalm 25:8-10: 8 Good and upright is the LORD; therefore he instructs sinners in his ways. 9 He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them his way. Not exalting ourselves, remembering we need God. But he desires to use us.
- Spend time in the Word of God: 2Timothy 3:16-17: <sup>16</sup>All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> so that the servant of God\_may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
- 3) Pray Continually: Prayer is communicating with God. We need to remember that we can talk to God anytime, any place. We Experience God's love:
  - Spend time in quiet and solitude
  - b. Engage in heart-felt worship
  - c. Converse with him throughout the days.
- 4) Rejoice Always: Rejoicing comes from remembering what God has done for you. The death and resurrection of Christ,; Brand new mercies each morning; Life; That <u>God is present</u> with us now and for all eternity.
