# **ANSWERING THE CALL**

☐ SCRIPTURE: 1 PETER 2:9-10; 1 SAMUEL 3:1-10

**key theme:** God does not expect us to find our calling by ourselves but to respond to what God has and continues to reveal. In each of the 4 dimensions of our calling, we must continually pay attention to God's call, respond to it in faith and diligently walk out the responsibilities of the call.

# 1) HEARING THE CALL

- God calls us by name from birth. The issue is not whether God has called us, but whether we are truly recognizing his voice and hearing his call.
- b. There are many things that can cause us to misapprehend God's calling:
  - 1) Thinking that God must appear in a divine encounter in order for us to be appointed for service.
  - 2) Thinking that God isn't involved when we are called to seemingly "obvious" tasks.
  - 3) Assuming that our lack of understanding of what God is doing means that God doesn't know what he is doing.
  - 4) Refusing to attribute our success to God's leading in our life and
  - 5) Not understanding the progressive nature of God's call and thus, not understanding that seasons of preparation are as much a part of the call as are seasons of execution.

#### 2) ANSWERING THE CALL

- a. God calls us. We hear that call but must also respond.
- b. Instead of saying that "We can't find our calling in life," we should ask ourselves, "Are we ready to listen to God share with us his calling?"

# 3) WALKING WORTHY OF THE CALL

- a. Pitfalls of walking worthy of God's call
  - 1) Engaging in the comparison trap regarding our calling.
  - 2) Assuming that the only way that our calling has significance is if we are better than someone else.
  - 3) Not being satisfied with the scope of our calling.
