# WE ARE WATERED BY THE WORD OF GOD

☐ SCRIPTURE: EPHESIANS 5:22-32; PSALMS 138:2B

key theme: In order to BE the church, we must continually understand how Christ feeds and cares for his bride, the church, by using the Word of God (His Holy Scriptures) to nourish us and to wash us from the stain of sin.

- 1) We must understand that God desires for his people to be united as the "church" and to be married to Christ rather than dating Christ without a lasting commitment.
- 2) Marriage includes a responsibility to love and submit, to give of oneself, and to nurture the relationship.

## 3) To Love and Submit.

- In order for true submission to take place, one must recognize the
  position and authority that another possesses and make an active
  decision to change oneself on the basis of respect for that position
  and authority.
- Christ's position and authority gives Him the name that is above all names and His Word is exalted above all things. [Colossians 1, Philippians 2:5-11, Psalms 138:2b)

#### 4) To Give of Oneself

 You cannot have a marriage without a commitment to forsake other people, places and things that try to compete with your true spouse.

## 5) To Nurture the Relationship

God's way of nourishment is multi-faceted:

- He personally feeds and cares for us through his Word. (God initiates)
- b. He teaches each of us how to feed and care for ourselves according to his Word. (God empowers us)
- c. He uses the members of his body to feed and care for one another on the basis of his Word. (God collectively uses us)
- d. He uses the church (his people) to feed and care for a dying world. (God shines through us)
