PART II: GOD SPEAKS THROUGH PRAYER

SCRIPTURE: JEREMIAH 33:1-3; PSALMS 27:4-9

key theme: Prayer is fellowship with God through Jesus Christ through which believers draw near to God and learn more of his will for their lives.

- God reveals himself in prayer in various ways. We must pay attention in prayer to apprehend how God is speaking whether: His creative order, prophetic voice, dreams, visions, miracles, providence, circumstances, angels + audible voice.
- 2) We must have the correct posture as we enter into prayer
 - We must remember that He knows everything that we need before we ask him. We are coming to him to receive from him. [Matt 6:7-8]
 - b. The Prophet Jeremiah recognized that he was asking of the Lord who made the earth. Is anything too hard for this God to answer in prayer?
- God promises that when we call on Him, He will answer us. It may not be the answer we are looking for, but it is the answer that we need. [Jer 33:3]
- 4) 3 Aspects of Prayer and God's Response
 - Worship praise, adoration, thanksgiving
 God's Response presence + peace
 - Inquiry/Evaluation confession, instruction, guidance
 God's Response grace + wisdom
 - c. Petition intercession, deliveranceGod's Response provision
