PART I: THE PRIORITY AND CONTEXT OF VISION

SCRIPTURE: NEHEMIAH 1:3-4: HABAKKUK 2:2-4

key theme

What is vision and why is it important for our lives?

- Vision is a clear and compelling strategic understanding of God's purposes that allows us to focus our time, energy, and talents.
- 2) Vision gives us hope, passion + a call to remain steadfast.
- 3) While we may be inspired with ideas, true vision comes from God's sharing in the plans that he has for us.
- 4) Vision starts with what does God say about a situation / circumstance / relationship / responsibility / need?
- Our challenge is to ask God not only for vision, but an understanding of how the vision intersects.
 - Every vision is for an appointed time, so if you have a picture of what God desires but not God's priority, then you don't truly have the picture that God has for you.
